#### > Describe your project idea

##### *Abstract*

Small and Medium Enterprises urgently need tailored business services to support them in overcoming the challenging requirements to operate effectively and safely their ongoing business. The driving force is the need to conform fully to the complex legal and social requirements in the fields of Environment, Health, Safety and Quality (EHS-Q) and to reduce the work overload of the key personnel.
